



Intellectual property rights are very important to Hart Print. If there are elements present in your files that are protected content, we have the right to refuse the file. These include:

- Commercial products and objects such as devices, fashion items, or furniture that is otherwise identifiable but color, form, etc.
- Trademarks such as logos and company names
- Locations, venues, monuments, landmarks that have photography restrictions such as zoos, museums, theme parks, etc.
- Architecture, certain buildings require the image to not have it as the focal point, but rather as part of the skyline for example.
- Copyrighted objects such as artworks, fonts, graphic elements, etc.
- We will only publish protected designs if you can provide us with an appropriate permit.

And for your protection, we, Hart Print, will not use artwork given to us to print for any other purpose without written consent by the original creator. Any artwork will be rejected if they contain illegal content, hate speech, pornography or glorify violence. Legally prohibited content will not be printed, as well as images or names of real-life persons who are entitled to a right to privacy.
